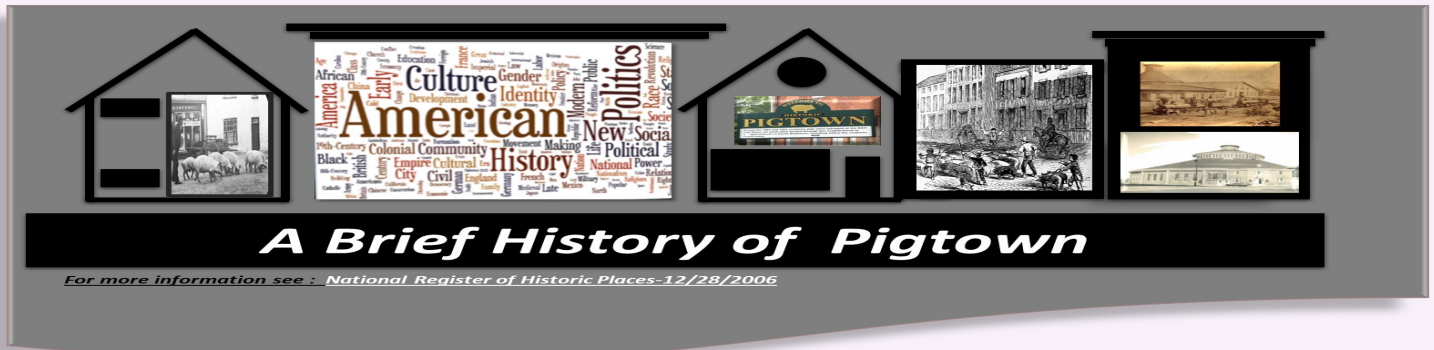

The area where Pigtown is now located was originally part of the Mount Clare plantation, a 2,368-acre estate owned by Dr. Charles Carroll in the 18th century. Carroll built one of Maryland's first iron foundries on the property, which operated the largest pig iron furnace in the colonies prior to the American Revolution. Dr. Carroll was a cousin of Charles Carroll of Carrollton, who signed the Declaration of Independence.

In 1827, the Baltimore & Ohio Railroad was founded in Baltimore. Ground was broken on the Mount Clare property in 1828, with the first stone laid by Charles Carroll of Carrollton, at the age of 90. Initially providing service between Baltimore and Ellicott Mills (now Ellicott City, Maryland), the railroad began operating along West Pratt Street on May 22, 1830. The horse drawn cars of the early B&O Railroad were the nation's first regular passenger rail.

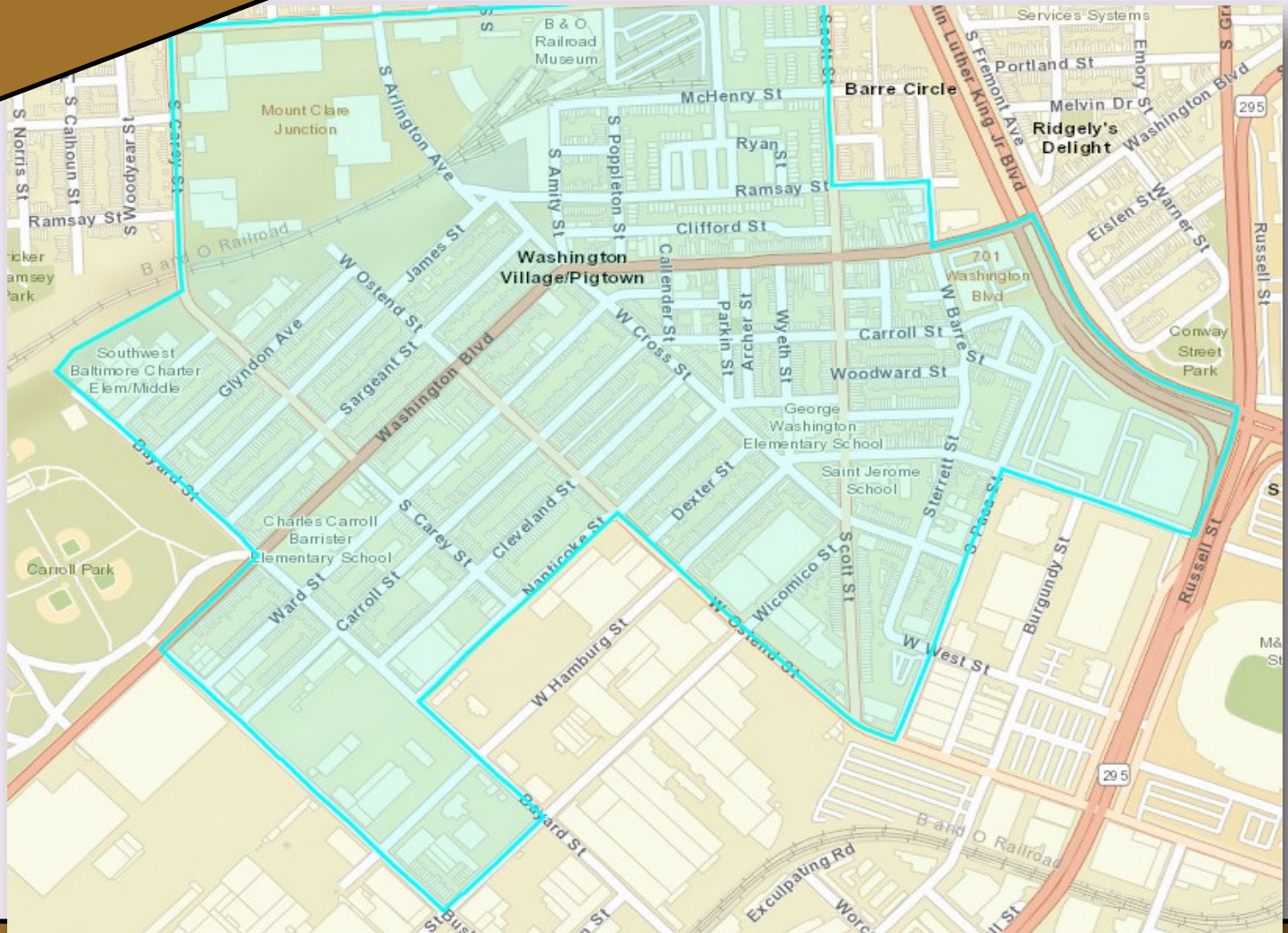
Construction of the first houses to the north and south of the railroad yards began in 1833. A community of railroad workers grew along Columbia Avenue (now Washington Boulevard) in the 1840s, followed by industrial development in the 1850s and 1860s. Slaughter houses located near the railroad yards earned the area its name as Pigtown as workers herded pigs for slaughter and processing to shops and packing plants across the streets from the rail cars.

Although official records have identified the neighborhood as Washington Village at various points since the 1970s, it has been consistently labeled as Pigtown since 2006 at the insistence of community groups such as Southwest Community Council, Inc.



It earned its name (and mascot) in the second half of the same century, when cargo railcars from the Midwest would swing open their doors at the nearby platform to let carloads of pigs out.

Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard to the east, Monroe Street to the west, Russell Street to the south, and West Pratt Street to the north. The neighborhood acquired its name during the second half of the 19th century, when the area was the site of butcher shops and meat packing plants to process pigs transported from the Midwest on the B&O Railroad; they were herded across Ostend and Cross Streets to be slaughtered and processed.

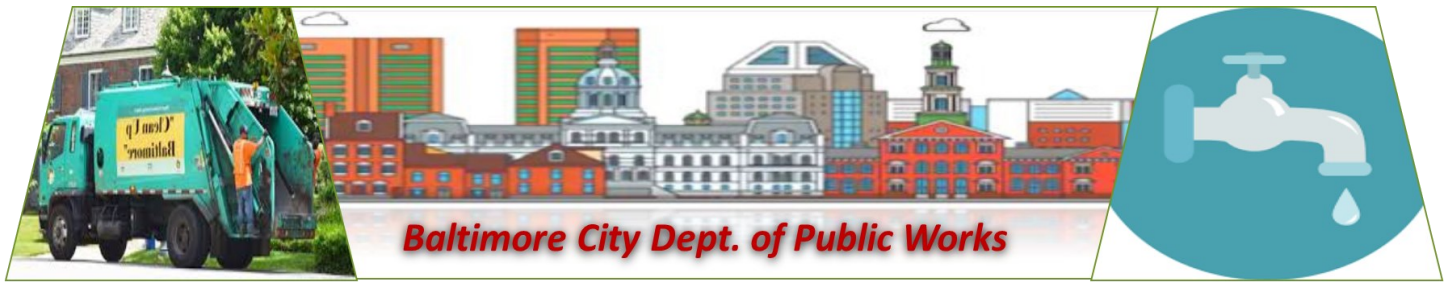

Recycling

Recycle as much as you want and don't worry about separating bottles from cans, or anything else for that matter. The city does that for you. Single stream recycling pick-ups happen weekly. Unlike regular trash pickups, you can leave as much as you want and they'll gladly haul it away. To learn when your recycling collection is scheduled, call 311 or visit BaltimoreCity.gov for the recycling calendar.

Trash Collection

Trash collection also happens weekly. In addition, the Baltimore City Department of Public Works Bureau of Solid Waste also coordinates bulk trash pickups. To learn when your residential trash collection is scheduled, call 311 or check out City View, an online resource that helps you find your trash schedule and lots of other useful information about every neighborhood in the city. Once on City View, enter your address in the search box above the map. On the left hand side, select "City Services" as your thematic overlay. Then select "Trash and Recycling Day" as your layer. Zoom out on the map and you will see your pick-up day!

Provides assistance, when funds are available, to eligible vulnerable adults. Assists with BG&E turn off notices, eviction prevention (must have been to court), burial assistance on a case by case basis, and purchasing a bed. Individuals must bring proof of need and proof of income to be screened for eligibility. For assistance with a bed, individuals must bring proof of income and a statement (from a furniture store; this could be Lexaco)

with the purchase price. Individuals can walk in for assistance Mon-Fri, 8:30AM-12:15PM and 1:30-4:15PM). Will assist individuals in public housing/Section 8. Individuals are eligible for assistance once a year to receive a grant of up to \$800.

Expired Residential Permits Remain Valid Until Further Notice

The Baltimore City Department of Transportation resumed parking enforcement of Residential Permit Parking on Tuesday, September 1, 2020. Permits that expired after March 2020 will be honored until the Governor lifts the Emergency Order.

Residents who need a new permit can apply online at pabc.thepermitstore.com if they meet one of the following criteria:

- You are a **NEW** RPP customer who has not been able to purchase a permit due to the COVID-19 closure of PABC offices.
- You are an existing customer who has purchased a **new vehicle** or has **new license plates**.
- You are an existing customer who **moved from one RPP area to another**. If you moved within the same RPP area, you may continue to use the decal and visitor permit(s) you already have.

Residents who qualify can apply online at pabc.thepermitstore.com to have a permit mailed to them. The online application will allow residents to upload the required documents that are usually verified in person at the Parking Authority Office or at a Community Pickup. A Parking Authority team member will verify the documents online and mail residents their permits.

Residential Decal

What is it?

A permit that exempts a resident's vehicle from posted parking restrictions in a residentially restricted parking area. Decals are affixed on the inside windshield of the vehicle on the driver's side. Decals must be renewed annually.

In each Residential Permit Parking (RPP) Area, qualified residences are eligible for up to four (4) decals per household. Required documentation must be verified before permits are issued. Each permit costs \$20 per year.

Terms of use apply including the verification of [Required Documents](#) each year.

Where do I get a Residential Decal?

If you are obtaining a decal for the first time, you must come to the Parking Authority of Baltimore City located at [200 W. Lombard Street, Baltimore, Maryland, 21201](#). If you are driving, please park at the Arena Garage above our office at 99 S. Howard Street. Pass our office on Lombard Street, turn right onto Howard Street and take your first right into the garage. Tell the receptionist you would like your parking validated.

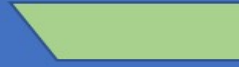




Pigtown Residential Permit Parking Areas

Proof of identity and residency are required of all applicants for a new Maryland driver's license, learner's permit or identification (ID) card; please use the online document guide to assist you with what to bring to the MVA.

The Maryland Motor Vehicle Administration will verify the information provided on your application to determine eligibility.

All applicants for a driver's license are checked with the National Driver Registry. If your license is suspended, revoked, canceled or refused, you are not eligible for a Maryland driver's license.

Drivers must meet certain vision requirements. Visit the MVA's vision requirements page for additional information.

The Maryland Department of Transportation's Motor Vehicle Administration (MVA) is now printing/mailling one of the most secure driver's licenses, learner's permits and identification (ID) cards in the nation. All cards are now delivered through the mail within 4-7 business days. The new cards incorporate cutting-edge security features to help protect against identity theft and fraud. The new cards also meet all state and federal standards and are REAL ID compliant. As always, we encourage customers to **Skip the Trip** and renew their driver's license or ID card via web, kiosk and mail. The MVA's online services can be found [here](#). On November 6, 2019, Paul's Place broke ground on Groundwork Kitchen, the future home of our culinary arts training program and restaurant, located at 925 Washington Boulevard just around the corner from our main facility and offices. Executive Director Bill McLennan and Board Chair Susan Owens welcomed community and city leaders, partners, volunteers, staff and donors to partake in the occasion, which included a ceremonial shoveling of dirt. The event officially marked the beginning of construction on the \$10 million project – a 15,000-square-foot building that will house a 150-seat restaurant and training facilities where classes of up to 15 persons aged “18 to 80” will learn front-of-house and back-of-house skills. Expected completion of Groundwork Kitchen is fall 2020.

In 2015, Baltimore adopted the South Baltimore Gateway Master Plan, a sweeping plan to improve neighborhoods near the casino. The City then began to implement this plan, with the advice of the Local Development Council (LDC) and funding provided by the Local Impact Grants generated by video lottery terminals.

It soon became clear that another organization was also needed to help spend these funds – something that could be flexible, nimble, and entrepreneurial. So in 2016, the South Baltimore Gateway Partnership was established. Now the City and the Partnership split Baltimore's share of the Local Impact Grants.

In order to successfully implement the ambitious agenda laid out in the Master Plan, we created our own Strategic Plan to narrow our focus to a few key areas. We intend to make decisive change in a few critical topics, rather than having a minor impact on many.

Under our Strategic Plan, we will spend the coming years focusing on three crucial elements of the South Baltimore Gateway Master Plan: Environmental Sustainability, Health and Wellness, and Community Development and Revitalization.

We also have divided our work into three program areas: Community Grants, Enhanced Services, and Transformational Projects.

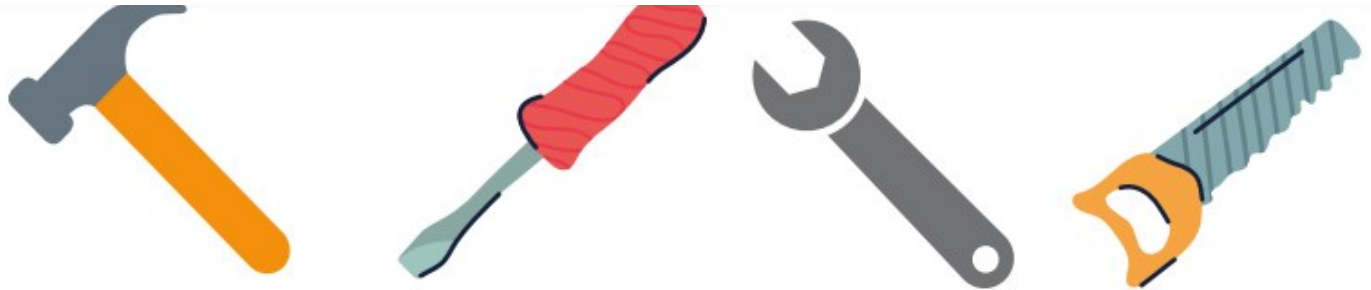

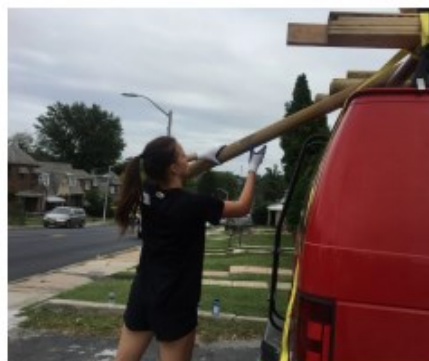

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What is Rebuilding Together Baltimore?

A: Rebuilding Together Baltimore is a non-profit organization that was founded in 1989. We provide home repairs to low income homeowners who are seniors, people with disabilities, and families with children in Baltimore City and Baltimore County. All repairs are provided at no charge to the homeowners. We have assisted over 1,600 homeowners since we were founded.

Q: How do you provide the repairs for free?

A: We receive generous financial support from the corporate community as well as the government and local foundations. We use this money to pay contractors and purchase the materials needed for the repairs that we do. Volunteers do many of the repairs, saving us thousands of dollars in labor costs. For the safety of all home owners and volunteers, volunteer work is currently on hold due to COVID restrictions.

Q: When are the repairs done?

A: Repairs are completed by contractors throughout the year. If volunteers are slated to do some of the repairs on the home, the volunteer projects usually take place in the Spring and Summer.

Q: That sounds a lot like "Christmas in April". What ever happened to that program?

A: Rebuilding Together is the same as Christmas in April. We changed our name in 2000.

Q: What kind of repairs do you do?

A: Repairs are prioritized based on the 8 principles of Healthy Housing: 1. Keep it DRY 2. Keep it CLEAN 3. Keep it PEST-FREE 4. Keep it SAFE 5. Keep it CONTAMINANT-FREE 6. Keep it WELL VENTILATED 7. Keep it MAINTAINED 8. Keep it THERMALLY CONTROLLED. Repairs can include roof repair, energy efficiency improvements, repair of safety hazards, and fall/injury prevention interventions for seniors and people with disabilities. We can do many different types of repairs. What we do depends on the condition of the home, the availability of funding and the skills of our volunteers.

Q: Is this like the TV show, "Extreme Makeover"?

A: No. We can't rehabilitate or build an entire house like they do on TV. We target repairs that will make the home warmer, safer, and drier, and help to revitalize the community. The home will be more comfortable and safer to live in, and will probably look nicer, but it won't be a complete makeover.

Q: What does the initial application process look like?

A: In short, we ask you to complete an application form, agree to our guidelines, and provide us with documentation showing you meet our income guidelines. If you meet our basic criteria, our staff will visit your home to assess repair needs and determine if the repair needs are within our capacity to address.

Q: Is everyone who applies guaranteed to get help?

A: Unfortunately, we cannot guarantee that everyone who applies will be accepted into the program. We have limited resources and must prioritize homes based on need as well as the skills and abilities of our volunteers.

Q: What do you expect from homeowners if their home is selected?

A: If a home is selected for work, we ask that the homeowner works with staff and volunteers to prioritize and plan the repairs. We also ask that any able-bodied residents of the home, or relatives who live in the area, be present to help volunteers with the repairs.
